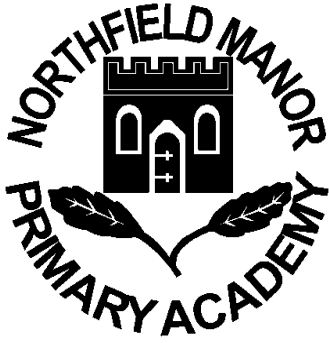

Dear Parents and Carers,

3MB visit to Sarehole Museum

Year 3's learning challenge is 'How can we make an educational film about the Stone Age?'. We have booked a visit on Thursday 12th September to Sarehole Museum so that the children can learn more about this. The children will be taking part in a workshop which takes part in two sessions. During the first session the children will learn about the Stone Age to Bronze Age, handle genuine prehistoric artefacts, build shelters and explore a real Bronze Age in the local woodland. The second session will focus on Stone Age art. The children will explore prehistoric art and discover how and why art pieces were created. Children will then make their own paintbrushes before creating their own artwork. This trip will be very beneficial to your child's learning so we would like all children to attend,

We will be travelling by coach and will leave school at 9:15am to return by 3:20pm.

Please provide your child with a packed lunch to take along. This should be in a named bag that can be disposed of after lunch (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles). If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, the school kitchen will provide a packed lunch for them.

All children should wear their own clothes (which they do not mind getting dirty), including a waterproof coat, sensible shoes, a sunhat/sun cream (weather dependent) and will not need any spending money.
