Year 3 Visit to The British Museum

This term we are learning about 'Ancient Egypt'. To support the children in their learning we have arranged a visit to The British Museum in London on Monday 10th February. The British Museum holds the largest collection of Egyptian objects outside Egypt and is an excellent place to learn about life and death in the Nile Valley.

In order to make the most of the day we will need to make an early start. We will leave school at **7.15am** to return at approximately **6.30pm**. All children will require a packed lunch on this day (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please). If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, a packed lunch will be provided by the school kitchen. Please also send a couple of small snacks along for your child to have during the day.

During the trip the children will explore the museum and visit the Egyptian galleries. They will also be taking part in a workshop which focuses on excavations from Ancient Egypt. During this workshop children will handle replica objects and discover the fascinating contents of an ancient tomb. This is an excellent opportunity for the children to visit one of the largest and best museums in the world.

The full cost of this visit is £17.51 per child.

All children are required to wear full school uniform for this trip and will not need any spending money.
