

Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that yesterday's home learning went well and that the children enjoyed completing the activities. Any problems or questions please do not hesitate to ask – we are here to help. We had some lovely photos of children's work messaged to us through dojo yesterday and would love to see more this week, we have been really impressed so far. We are happy to see anything that the children have done and are proud of, even if it is something that has not been set as a task by us. Here are the activities we would like the children to complete today:

Tuesday 21st April

Phonics- Read the word and match it to the correct picture. The children can either draw a line from the word to the picture or cut out the words and pictures and match them together. Children accessing pack 1 will be focusing on the /th/ and /ng/ sound and those accessing pack 2 will focus on words containing three phonemes (single sounds).

Maths- Number formation

Can children practise forming their numbers correctly? Watch the "numeral song" on Youtube to help: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=wkg59TtLq8o>

Practise 1-5, then 5-10 if they can do 1-5.

Challenge- Can they write their numbers in order to 20?

Handwriting- Write the letters v and w and then write your full name. You can show these videos to your child as guidance on how to form the letters correctly:
