Below are the activities we would like the children to do today:

Phonics

Match the picture to the word. Either cut them out and match them together or draw the picture in your activity book and write the word next to it.

Maths- How many altogether

Talk about what altogether means. For example, show children different amounts of objects and ask 'how many are altogether?' 'how can we find this out?' Explain that they need to count them all to find out how many there are altogether. Can the children help to set the dinner table? How many sets of cutlery do they need? Ask 'how many people are in our family?' Then children can count how many items they have altogether. Can they find all their teddies/shoes/socks? How many do they have altogether?
