## Phonics

Today we are focusing on tricky words.

Positional language- Play "Hide and Seek" in your home. Can your child describe their position while they are hiding? For example, "I was behind the sofa", "I was under the table".

#### <u>Thematic</u>

Discuss these questions with your child.

How are they similar? What do they both do for others?

Would you rather be a giant or an elf why? Extra challenge- could you write a sentence about your choice e.g. "I would like to be a giant because..."
