

Work packs (for work to cover the period 15th June – 26th June)

This letter contains new information about the work packs. Please read and ask your class teacher if you have any questions.

Paper packs have been produced for *all* children – *you do not need to have ordered one*. All packs will also be available to download from the school website. Work will continue to be sent through Dojo.

These packs contain 2 weeks of work to start in the week beginning 15th June. Packs will be collected the week before – the week beginning 8th June.

All paper copies of work packs are labelled with the child's name.

Responding to feedback from parents, the best practice elsewhere and the latest research guidance, we have adapted the packs to support the engagement and progress of your children. Teachers will send out videos modelling some of the concepts, so please ensure you are using Class Dojo.

Some QR codes will be used to help access web links more quickly. You can use these by downloading an app on your phone/tablet – search QR Code Reader in the App Store or Play Store, depending on whether you're Apple or Android. If you do not have access to the QR code reader, links will still be provided so your child will not miss out on the learning.

If you have children in multiple year groups, you can collect all of their packs at the same time. For example, if you have children in Reception and Y2, you could collect both packs either Monday morning (the Reception slot) or Tuesday morning (the Year 2 slot).

Please maintain social distancing. Peak times are likely to be at the start and end of a slot, so try to avoid these if possible.
