Phonics 23/6/2020

Pack 1

Watch the following video that will aid children's use of the /ur/ digraph:

Draw it Activity — Read the word/caption and draw a picture of it in the box.

Pack 2

/ai/ words (as in pain)

Read the words and draw a line to the picture that matches

Maths 23/6/2020

This activity could be completed with toys, sweets or something your child would be quick to point out hasn't been shared fairly! Get two plates/boxes or baskets and a group of toys, sweets, biscuits etc and purposefully share them unfairly. Ask your child if you have shared the objects out equally; when they point out your mistake ask them to explain what you have done wrong. Allow your child to correct your mistake and address any misconceptions that they may have. Encourage them to use language such as "share", "half", "fair", "same" "equal". The treat at the end could be that they get to eat or play with whatever they have been using.

Extra challenge- Challenge your child with the question "can you halve all numbers fairly?"

Handwriting 23/6/2020

Pack 1

Please dictate this sentence to your child and ask them to write it in their neatest handwriting. Remind them of writing on the line and keeping their letters the same size.

Extra challenge- write another sentence with a word containing the /ur/ sound.

Pack 2

Ask your child to practise writing the /ai/ grapheme using their best handwriting. Remind them to write the a first and to use a finger space after the i.
