- 3 Use a ruler to draw the lines.

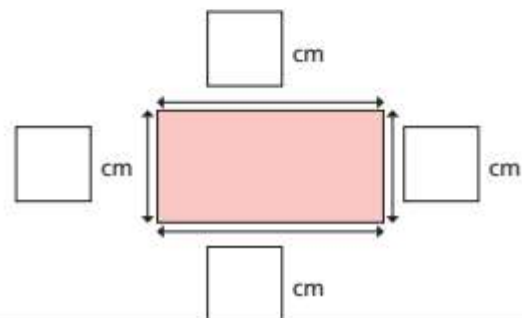
