Dear Parents and Carers,

3RS visit to Sarehole Museum

To support the children in their thematic sessions, we have booked a visit to Sarehole Museum on **Thursday 4th November** so that the children can learn about how society advanced during prehistoric Britain. This trip is very beneficial to your child's learning this term so we would like all the children to attend.

The children will be participating in a workshop which takes part in two sessions. During the first session, the children will learn about the Stone Age to Bronze Age, will handle genuine prehistoric artefacts, build shelters and explore a real Bronze Age in the local woodland. The second session will focus on Stone Age art. The children will explore prehistoric art and discover how and why art pieces were created. Children will then make their own paintbrushes before creating their own artwork.

We will be travelling by coach to the museum leaving at **9.15am** to return by **3pm**. Children should arrive at school at the normal time. Please provide your child with a packed lunch to take along. This should be in a named bag that can be disposed of after lunch (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles). If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, the school kitchen will provide a packed lunch for them.

All children should wear their own clothes (which they do not mind getting dirty), including a waterproof coat, sensible shoes, a sunhat/sun cream (weather dependent) and will not need any spending money.

The full cost of the visit is **£17.84** per child. If you would like your child to take part in this visit, please make full payment on Parent Pay by **9am on Friday 22nd October 2021**.
